

A REFERRAL PARTNERSHIP, NOT A COMPETITOR

You own the application. We build *the student behind it*.

HOW THE PARTNERSHIP WORKS

STEP 1 · 20 MINUTES

Intro call. We walk you through the program, the mentor vetting standard, and exactly where the referral line sits.

STEP 2 · WARM REFERRAL

You introduce, we onboard. A simple three-way email. We match the student to a mentor within one week and handle everything from there.

STEP 3 · SHARED VISIBILITY

You stay informed. With the family's consent, you receive the monthly report — so the development work feeds directly into yours.

Safeguarding is the foundation, not a feature. Every mentor is identity-verified and vetted, every session is logged, and mentors are trained on bright-line escalation — they mentor, they never counsel or treat. Concerns route to a designated safeguarding lead immediately.

Founded by a former professional academy footballer (*Aston Villa, MK Dons*) turned D1 athlete and platform builder — mentorship designed by someone who lived both sides of the transition.
