

AN EXTENSION OF YOUR PASTORAL CARE, NOT A REPLACEMENT

Your caseload is hundreds of students.

Some need more hours than exist.

You know exactly which students they are: not in crisis, not failing — just drifting. No system for their week, no resilience after a setback, no older figure paying real attention. Mentora pairs them with rigorously vetted college-athlete and near-peer mentors who do the week-by-week development work no counseling caseload has room for — structured, logged, and reported to parents monthly.

AGES 12-14

High School Ready

A 12-month program built around the transition into upper school: time ownership, resilience after setbacks, self-knowledge, composure under pressure, and confidence in new rooms.

AGES 15-18

College Ready

The maturity layer under everything school asks of them: independence, follow-through, and a student who can advocate for themselves — in class, in applications, and beyond.

WHY SCHOOLS RECOMMEND MENTORA

01

Capacity, without headcount

A structured weekly mentorship for the students you're most concerned about — at no cost to the school. Families enroll directly; you simply open the door.

02

Visibility you don't have today

With family consent, you receive the monthly development report — commitments kept, capability trends, mentor observations. Signal on students between your check-ins.

03

A cleaner referral option

For the student who doesn't need clinical support but does need structure and a role model, you finally have a right-sized recommendation to give parents.

HOW THE PARTNERSHIP WORKS

STEP 1 · 20 MINUTES

Intro call. We walk you through the program, the mentor vetting standard, and how it sits alongside your pastoral structure.

STEP 2 · FAMILY INTRODUCTION

You recommend, families enroll. A note home or a name in a parent meeting. We onboard the family directly and match a mentor within one week.

STEP 3 · SHARED VISIBILITY

You stay in the loop. With the family's consent, monthly reports reach you as well — so mentorship and pastoral care pull in the same direction.

Safeguarding is the foundation, not a feature. Every mentor is identity-verified and vetted, every session is logged, and mentors are trained on bright-line escalation — they mentor, they never counsel or treat. Concerns route to a designated safeguarding lead immediately.

Founded by a former professional academy footballer (*Aston Villa, MK Dons*) turned D1 athlete and platform builder — mentorship designed by someone who lived both sides of the transition.
